

Kids' EE Materials: The BIG 18

INTERACTIVE and **RELATIONAL** materials are vital to your Kids' EE ministry. The following list provides a brief explanation of the "BIG 18" key items. (Item order numbers are in parenthesis.)

1. **Kids' EE Leader's Manual: (K 102)** Manual is copyrighted.
Order Manuals for team leaders and assistants through www.kidsee.org or by calling 888-567-3543. This is a great investment to make, knowing that God will multiply your Kids' EE ministry through your team.
2. **Crafts and Activity Sheets: (Leader's Manual, "Fourteen Units" Section)** Each Unit contains the patterns and directions for paper crafts and activities. Paper materials can replace purchased trinkets for all lessons. The paper crafts appeal especially to kids with tactile and kinesthetic learning styles.
3. **Kids' EE Passport: (K 040)** This is equivalent to the Adult/Youth EE trainee notebook or workbook. Children meet weekly with their team leader. During team time, children review previous material and demonstrate their mastery of new material being taught. The Kids' EE Passport documents when students learn key concepts and Scriptures. Keep Passports with other EE materials. Too often, Passports are lost or left at home. Provide an additional Passport if kids want to practice materials at home.
4. **Farley Teaching Cards: (K022)** This set of 19 illustrated cards (each card is 8" X 10") is used to visually present the Gospel to the class. The Farley Cards tell the entire Gospel story, the Kids' EE way.
5. **Farley Sequencing Cards (K021)** Identical in content to the Farley Teaching Cards, this smaller set of cards (3" x 5") is perfect for Kids' EE participants, both kids and adults.

Participants can practice and learn the Gospel Presentation. When shuffled, these cards provide practice in sequencing. Individuals test their knowledge of the Gospel Presentation when they place the cards in the correct order. Place these 3" x 5" cards in a plastic baggie or on a key chain and carry in purse, backpack, or back pocket. Be ready to share the Gospel when opportunities arise.

6. **Farley Animated Gospel CD: (K055)** This is the same “cartoon” version that you can view on the Kids’ EE website. This CD allows children to hear, practice and share the Kids’ EE Gospel Presentation. Plays on computer only; full graphics and sound with beads to navigate from one section of Gospel to another. Makes a great “welcome gift” for families.
7. **Farley Figure: (Teacher’s Manual, Section III, “Getting Started”)** Farley is a stuffed figure, the size of a 10 year-old boy. He is the main character in Kids’ EE and a part of each Unit. During the 14-week session, Farley goes from pre-evangelized to saved to sharing his faith. (Pre-evangelized means he hasn’t heard the Gospel.) Farley is a source of interaction for teachers and children as they learn the Gospel Presentation. Watch the Kids’ EE animation at www.kidsee.org and read “Make a Farley Figure” to create Farley.
8. **Gospel-in-a-Nutshell Teaching Cards: (K 042)** These cards illustrate the Christ Section of the Gospel Presentation. Use them to introduce, teach, and reinforce the Gospel-in-a-Nutshell (Unit 4). The cards support the use of the nutshell picture strips for the nutshell or heart craft in this Unit.
9. **Gospel-in-a-Nutshell Picture Strips: (K 043)** These picture strips show the same illustrations of the Christ Section as the Gospel-in-a-Nutshell Cards; however, they are small enough to fold or fit into a peanut shell. Use these strips for the crafts in Unit 4. The pictures illustrate the major points of who Jesus Christ is and what He did. They are one of the first “Take-Home Truth” items participants use to share the Gospel with family and friends. Keep plenty in supply. Participants will use them as they share Jesus with others.

10. **Gospel Train Visual Teaching Cards: (K023)** This set of 8" x 10" Train Cards is used to introduce and reinforce the Gospel Outline. There is one "train car" for each part of the Gospel Outline (Grace, Man, God, Christ, Faith, Commitment). "Staying on track" is the theme when using these cards.
11. **Instructor's DVD: (KV 01)** This DVD is for teachers and team leaders as they prepare for teaching. It introduces and illustrates the teaching styles used in Kids' EE. DVD contains demonstrations of hand motions, skits and illustrations used in Kids' EE.
12. **Kids' EE Pins: (K PIN)** Lapel pin with Kids' EE logo and two question marks is a great graduation gift for kids, leaders and volunteers.
13. **Kids' EE Poster Set: (K 032)** Seven posters in this set include the six parts of the "Gospel Outline" and the "Bare Bones." A "Combination Poster" is available (**K 031**) which combines the six posters in one. These Farley Posters are used as teaching tools and for publicity purposes. They are strong visuals for each major section of the Gospel Outline.
14. **Kids' EE Tracts: (K 083)** Same design as Farley Cards, this Kids' EE tract is in mini-size. Give Kids' EE tracts to each participant so they can share the Gospel with others. The tract provides an effective visual reinforcement for the presentation of the Gospel message.
15. **Musical Listening CD, Choral Book and DVD: (K 048, K 047, K 052)** These items can be used to introduce the 10 Kids' EE songs during Kids' EE classes. Listening CD is a studio-made recording of "*The Big Trip*" Musical. The Choral Book contains the dialog and sheet music. Children can hear the Gospel in a fun, upbeat and meaningful "audio" way. DVD is the 35-minute presentation of "*The Big Trip*" performed at Christ Presbyterian Church in Nashville, TN.
16. **Power Pack: (K 041)** This booklet contains the eleven Bible verses presented at the Scripture Fun Fair. It is a compact collection of the main Bible verses used throughout Kids' EE. Its booklet size makes it ideal for easy carrying and convenient for practice time.

17. **Prayer/Commitment Cards: (K 046)** This card goes with the Commitment Sections (Unit 5 and 13). It is a follow-up to the Gospel-in-a-Nutshell taught in Unit 4. It helps children learn the key question and prayer associated with making a commitment.

18. **Take-Home Truth Items: (Suggestions in Each Unit and/or purchase through KIPP)** These are the novel and interesting objects kids take home to remind them of the spiritual truths they learn in class. Order these trinkets from KIPP (see “Getting Started” Section) or make them as craft projects. Kids use these items to share the Gospel with others.
